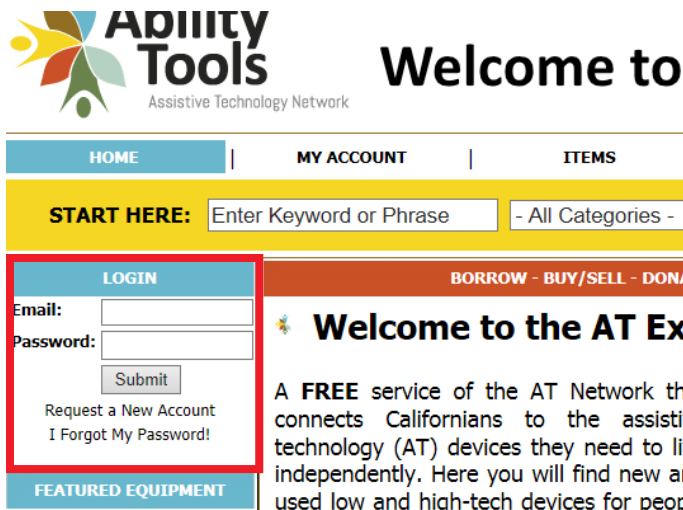


## Who can request an account?

## Step 1: Where do I request a new account?
